## ROUTE SURFACE

Primarily gravel roads, some paved segments. Gravel, cyclocross, hybrid or mountain bike recommended.

## ROUTE DESCRIPTION


A truly delightful ride, this route will take you on some of the most scenic gravel roads in Oxford County. From the small town of Plattsville connect onto Hubbard Road riding by a variety of small farmsteads to reach the shade of overhanging trees that line a part of the way cutting through lowland forest.

Routing east towards the pretty riverside setting and small community of Wolverton, slow down to enjoy the scenery and country side quiet. After a quick zigzag and bridge over the 401, connect onto more of the same, and another beautiful tranquil stretch north on King Road.

Add to the day a small detour to Bright Cheese for some fresh and tasty treats or pull into Walters Theatre for an afternoon matinee and performance set in the lovely country barn. Enjoy post ride refreshments on the patio at the aptly named Trail End Tavern upon your return to Plattsville.



### ROUTE NOTES:

Caution crossing at busier intersections of north south roadways and also short segment on bridge over Highway 401. Slow down for passing traffic and agricultural vehicles. Be aware that gravel roadways are maintained at various times throughout year, and while generally in good condition, may be in varied states of repair which can include fresh grading. As on all cycling routes, exercise caution at all times.
