EXPERIENCE LEVEL

Easy to moderate. Leisure/Recreational.

ROUTE SURFACE

Primarily gravel roads, some paved segments. Gravel, cyclocross, hybrid or mountain bike recommended.

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Make a quick escape to quiet rural farmland, just south of Woodstock, to enjoy this 28km gentle countryside gravel roll. Starting from the small hamlet of Oxford Centre, this looped gravel route is a great place to begin your gravel adventures in the area riding on quiet flat roads, with wide open vistas and 360 views of lush and abundant farmlands. Take some extra time to stop along the way and fill your paniers with local artisan goods, from soaps and beauty products at Wild Comfort, to tasty treats at Gunn's Hill Cheese, or add a small detour to Berrylicious Farm to get your berry-fill.

Circle back around for a delightful cruise north on Cedar Line, before the last 6km, a pretty meander on pavement back to Oxford Centre finish. For the gravel purists dip down a country line to use Firehall Road as an alternate and equally scenic route to the finish.

ROUTE NOTES:
